- 4- The Applicant will be required to fill in a Visa Application Form accurately and submit the same with the applicable visa fees, valid passport and the necessary documentation as specified therein.
- 5- GVS will accept no responsibility for late, lost or misplaced applications and/or the veracity of the contents of the same. Incomplete and duplicate applications will be disregarded. The Applicant accepts that the courier acceptance and delivery service is operated by a third party and GVS does not assume any responsibility or liability for any deficiency in service on part of the courier company.
