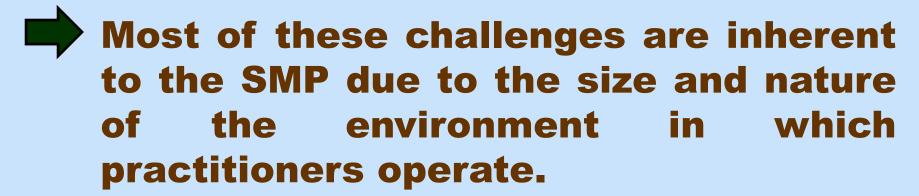
5) The SMPs World Internationally

The business environment in which an SMP operates is a challenging one and ever changing.

This presents both threats and opportunities.

- Retaining quality clients
- Attracting the type of clients you want
- Keeping up with changes in accounting and auditing standards
- Hiring and retaining qualified staff
- Staying on top of professional development requirements
- Balancing work and personal issues (family, leisure, further studies, etc)

6) Key Challenges faced by SMPs



An SMP in Kenya is always facing competition from the big five, both for its clients as well as for its staff (Consulting firms of every kind also poaching from SMPs).

- 6) Key Challenges faced by SMPs
- The SMP is constantly under siege from "TAKERS" of every kind.
- You are expected to give credit to clients vs cash flow demands.
- **Every challenge is matched by an opportunity → AND this is where my topic is for this session.**

- 6) Key Challenges faced by SMPs
 Mitigate the fee collection dilemma:-
- Fee Deposit Notes rather than fee notes
- Raise Fee Notes when fee is received
- Bill deposits + VAT when client confirms they will pay within 30 days thus manage VAT pressure 7

- 7) The Sleeping Giant SMP Opportunities
 - You are here to stay, do not be shaken
 - The world can not go around without you on board
 - You mid-wife the economy
 - Growing Businesses
 - Staff Development
- You are like a "fire engine" you go to the fire when the BIG FIVE firm is running away.

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8) SMP Image Management



Business leaders and professional accountants must recognize the importance of incorporating environmental, social & governance factors into all functions and processes – from strategic planning and goal setting, to external communications and reporting.

10) Growing your SMP: Lessons from emotional intelligence studies:-



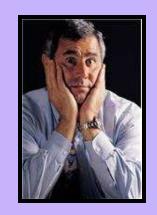
a) Self-Awareness

- Accurate self assessment: a realistic evaluation of your strengths and limitations.
- Self Confidence: a strong and positive sense of self-worth

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- 10) Lessons from emotional intelligence studies :
 - **b) Self-Management**



- Self Control: the ability to keep disruptive emotions and impulses under control
- Trustworthiness: a consistent display of honesty and integrity

- 10) Lessons from emotional intelligence studies :
 - b) Self-Management
 - Conscientiousness: the ability to manage yourself and your responsibilities
 - Adaptability: skill at adjusting to changing situations and overcoming obstacles
 - Initiative: a readiness to seize opportunities

10) Lessons from emotional intelligence studies:-

c) Social-Awareness

- Organizational awareness: the ability to read the currents of organizational life, build decision networks and navigate politics
- Service Orientation: the ability to recognize and meet customers needs

d) Social Skills

- Visionary leadership: the ability to take charge and inspire with a compelling vision
- Influence: the ability to wield a range of persuasive tactics



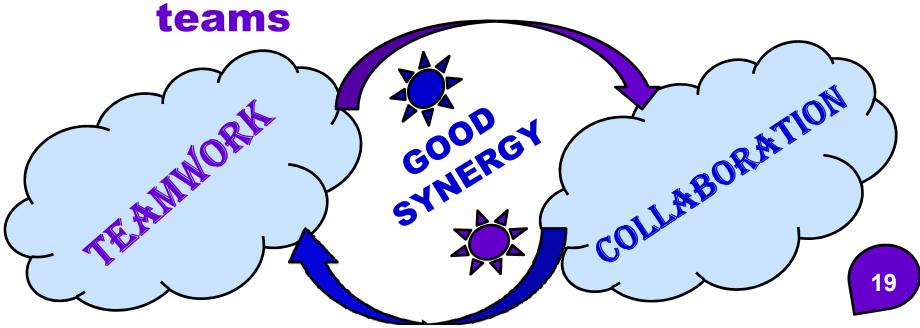
10) Lessons from emotional intelligence studies :-



d) Social Skills

- Developing others: the propensity to bolster the abilities of others through feedback and guidance
- e) Communication: skill at listening and at sending clear, convincing and well tuned messages

 - f) Teamwork and collaboration: competence at promoting cooperation and building
