German business lobbies to open Nairobi office

The Delegation of German Industry and Commerce (AHK Kenya) is expected in Nairobi for the official opening of new premises on Ojjo Road, Parklands. Among the high profile delegation from Germany is the CEO of the Association of German Chambers of Industry and Commerce Berlin. Also expected at the event are the German ambassador to Kenya Jutta Frasch and other

dignitaries from the Kenyan government.

Kenya hosts global standards board

Kenya is set to host the International Accounting Education Standards Board (IAESB) between April 17 and 20.

The meeting is organised jointly by the Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the Kenya Accounting and Secretaries National Examinations Board. IAESB is an independent standard setting body, under the International Federation of Accountants, and serves public interest by establishing standards in professional accounting education that prescribe technical



competence and professional skills, values, ethics and attitudes.

Kasneb launches new accounting course

The Kenya Accountants and Secretaries National Examinations Board (Kasneb) is set to launch a new certificate course.

The course targets Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) candidates who did not qualify for university admission. Out of the 615,773 candidates who sat KCSE exam last year, only 70,073 attained the university entry mean grade of C+. Nearly the same applies to 2016 KCSE exams.

"Uasu [University Academic Staff Union] officials shall be allowed a maximum of five years leave of absence from their duty station in their respective public university to enable them render service as an appointed union official," states the counter offer signed by Vice-Chancellor's Committee chairman Francis Adul.
