 Employ a consensus-building approach that can transform an adversarial issue into a cooperative decision-making process

Define the Problem

- Listen to all opinions objectively
- Understand and articulate the problem statement

Seek points of agreement

 Find points of agreement and set a positive tone around difficult issues

Work through the tough points

- Be innovative and willing to tackle tough issues
- Be ready to comprise

Follow-up and feedback

 Ensure there is continuous communication as the decision is being implemented to allow for corrective actions

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Why is corporate Governance so important?

- Ensures that a shareholder cannot unnecessarily contest the actions of the officers, leaving them more time to execute strategy.
