#### In 15 countries, total fertility is at 5 or more children per woman in 2015






dashed yellow line shows the projected fertility rate in 2050.

How the world's wealth is shared amongst its population, by income group













#### Mobile money in developing countries



Figure 1.6 ► Number and share of people without access to electricity by country, 2012






