Where there is no Moroccan embassy in your country, arrangements have been made with the authorities to ensure you receive a **Visa on Arrival** at the airport.

You should receive an automated confirmation letter after registration. If you haven't, you may [Send a request](#) for an invitation letter to support your visa application at an embassy in your country.

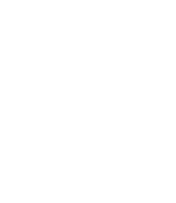

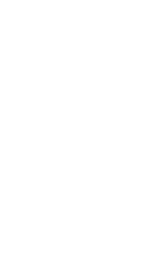
