



BACKGROUND

The Accountants Act underwent significant amendments through the Finance Act 2018. Among the notable amendments was the definition of the Accountant and the introduction of the Multiple Licensing regime by the Institute.

Following these critical amendments, ICPAK developed and launched the Multiple Licensing Regulations in November 2020. This paved way for the commencement for the application of the Multiple Licences by members from the 1st December 2020. The effective date for the operationalisation of the Multiple Licences will be the 1st January 2021.

Members who wish to practise are therefore notified to submit their applications for consideration under the various categories, namely;

Category A – Audit and Assurance

Category M – Accounting Controls and Consulting


Category T – Taxation services

Category C – Composite services




SNAPSHOT 1: HOMEPAGE




SNAPSHOT 2: LICENSE CATEGORIES
