- compliant and correct taxes are applied to all payments made and received.
- Work closely with company banks and other suppliers
- Work closely with sales team on client pricing and attend client meetings to present financial proposal
- Conduct regular department meetings with your team and manage payroll processing
- Ensure the Finance Department is adequately skilled and liaise with HR to ensure the department is adequately staffed and everyone has clear duties and responsibilities
