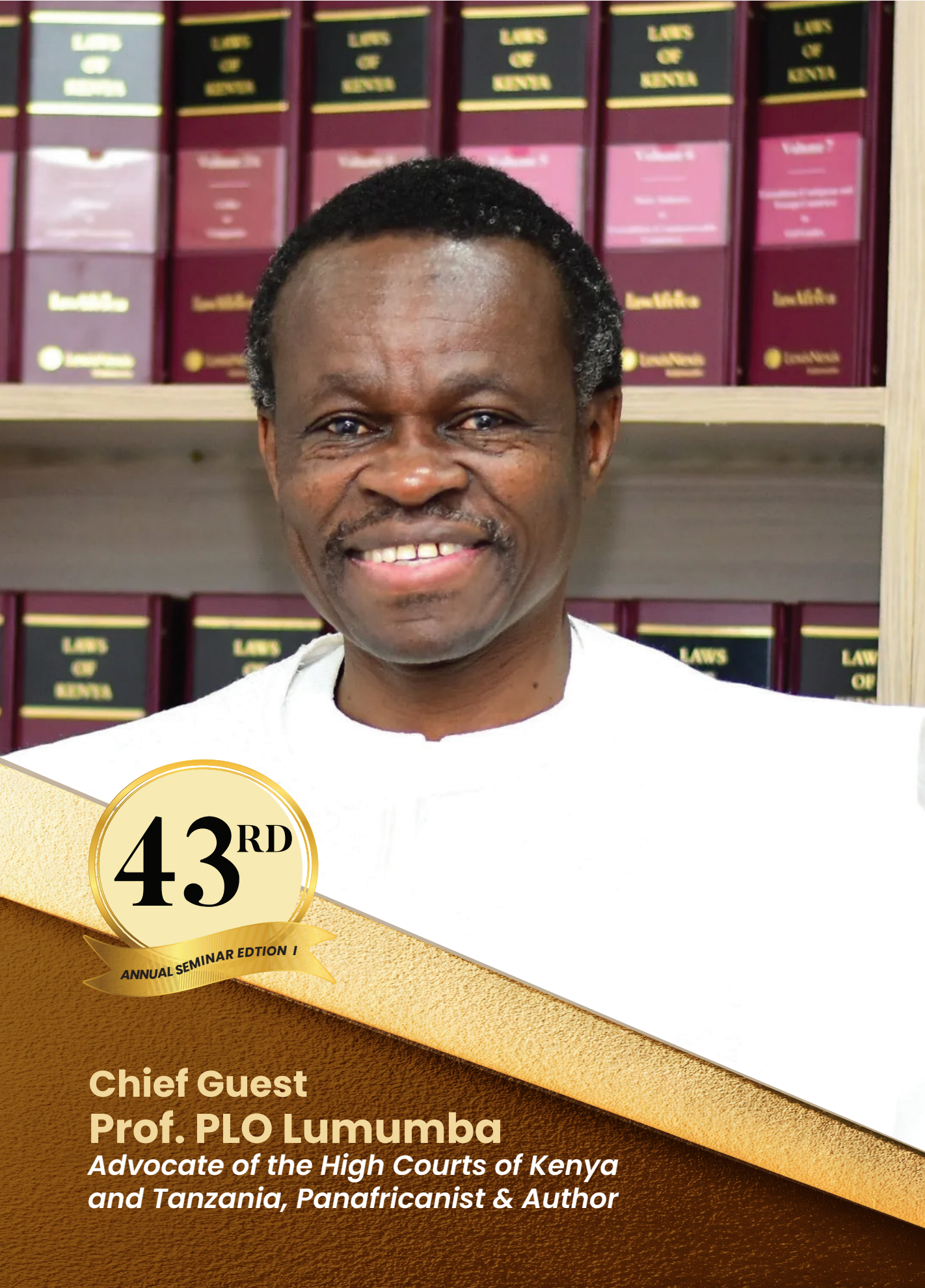

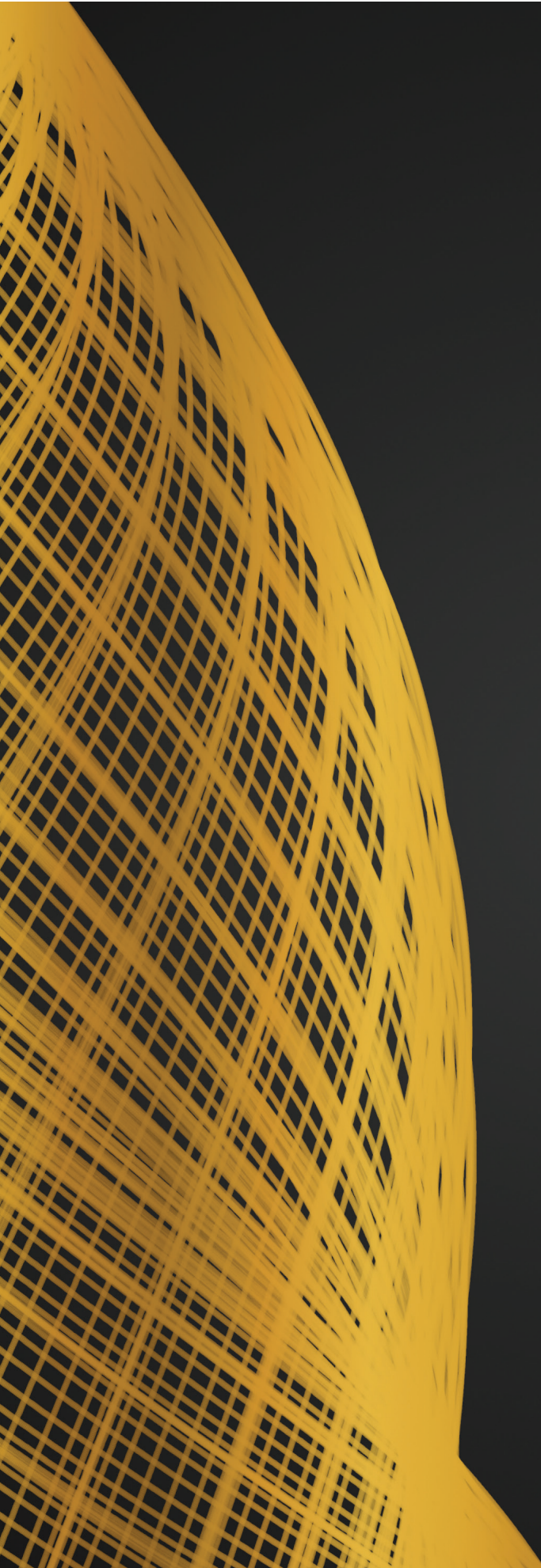

THE HOST

The Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya (ICPAK) is a regulatory body mandated to regulate and coordinate the activities of qualified and registered Certified Public Accountants (CPAs) in Kenya – including promoting research into the subject of accountancy and finance and related matters, publication of books, periodicals, journals and articles in connection therewith; promoting the international recognition of the Institute, advising the Examination Board on matters relating to examinations standards and policies, advising the Minister for Finance on matters relating to financial accountability in all sectors of the economy and setting and enforcing standards of professional practice such as accounting, auditing and ethical standards. The Institute is established by an Act of parliament – The Accountants Act and has been in existence since 1978. Over its long history it has registered over 40,000 members. A Brief History

For over four decades, the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya (ICPAK) has sustained a strong tradition of convening its members annually to reflect on the evolving accountancy profession and emerging issues shaping the national, regional and global landscape. Since the inaugural Annual Seminar held in 1984, the forum has grown into the Institute's flagship professional development event, symbolizing resilience, unity and the profession's unwavering commitment to the public interest.

The 43rd ICPAK Annual Seminar celebrates 43 years of thought leadership, professional engagement, and reflective practice in the accounting profession. Building on the momentum of previous editions that explored sustainability reporting, climate change, and the evolving role of accountants, the 2026 seminar will highlight the transformative impact of professional accountants as strategic leaders and influencers in organizations.

Scheduled for 18th to 22nd May 2026, this edition will convene professional accountants, regulators, policymakers, business leaders, public sector officials, and development partners from Kenya, the East African region, and across Africa. The Seminar will emphasize the pivotal role of accountants in driving organizational growth, shaping strategic decisions, and fostering transformation while upholding integrity, ethics, and accountability amidst heightened regulatory scrutiny. Through a carefully curated program combining technical expertise, policy insights, and reflective sessions, participants will be equipped to lead with influence, reinforce governance and ethical standards, ensure transparency in financial and non-financial reporting, and drive meaningful organizational and societal impact.

Hon. Lady Justice Philomena Mwilu, EGH, Deputy Chief Justice & Vice President of the Supreme Court of Kenya.

The Honourable Lady Justice Philomena Mbeti Mwilu, EGH was appointed on 28th October 2016 as the 3rd Deputy Chief Justice and Vice President of the Supreme Court of Kenya. Lady Justice Mwilu is an Advocate of the High Court of Kenya with over 38 years of experience in the legal profession and holds both a Bachelor and Master of Laws degrees from the University of Nairobi. She was admitted as an Advocate of the High Court of Kenya in 1984.

Lady Justice Mwilu was in private legal practice in various law firms in Nairobi for the first seven years following her admission to the Bar. Thereafter she ventured into the corporate world working as a Senior Legal Officer in insurance; Board Secretary in charge of the day-to-day running of a State Corporation in regulation; the Deputy Chairperson of the Energy Tribunal; and later as

Director on the Board of the Nairobi Water and Sewerage Company before being appointed a Puisne Judge in 2007.

Lady Justice Mwilu served in the Commercial Division of the High Court in Nairobi and later the High Court in Eldoret. She subsequently served at the Criminal Division High Court in Nairobi and thereafter, was appointed to head the Environment and Land Division. In November 2012, she was appointed a Judge of Appeal where she served until she was appointed the Deputy Chief Justice.

As Vice-President of the Supreme Court of Kenya, Lady Justice Mwilu is responsible for the co-ordination of the overall performance and supervision of the Court and indeed the entire Judiciary. On 26th January 2017, Her Ladyship was appointed by to serve as the Judiciary Ombudsman.

On 3rd May, 2017, she was elected by her colleague Justices of the Supreme Court to represent them as a Commissioner at the Judicial Service Commission for a term of five years. Upon the retirement of Chief Justice Emeritus Hon. Mr. Justice David K. Maraga on 12th January, 2021, Lady Justice Mwilu assumed the Office of Chief Justice in acting capacity pending the recruitment and appointment of the current Chief Justice, Hon. Justice Martha Koome. The Hon. Deputy Chief Justice is the Chair of the Judiciary Management Committee.

In the discharge of her social responsibility, Lady Justice Mwilu is passionate about mentoring girls and boys in schools across the country, using her experience and example to promote positive, wholesome and healthy futures for young adults and especially the girl child in Kenya. For her service to society, the Deputy Chief Justice was decorated on 11th April, 2017 by the Head of State, H. E. Uhuru Kenyatta, with the award of Moran of the Golden Heart, and later on December 12, 2024, she was awarded the Elder of the Order of the Golden Heart by H.E. Dr William Ruto.



Prof. PLO Lumumba is a Professor of Public Law, a holder of an LL.D (Doctor of Laws) on the Law of the Sea from the University of Ghent, Belgium, Master of Laws degree and a Bachelor of Laws degree from the University of Nairobi. Prof PLO Lumumba holds an honorary Degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.) (Honoris Causa) from the University of Cape Coast in Ghana. He is also a holder of the Degree of Doctor of Science (DSc) (Honoris Causa) from Bells University of Technology in Nigeria. He has been trained on Humans Rights at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies, University of London in England, Humanitarian Law at the Raoul Wallenberg Institute of the University of Lund in Sweden and on International Humanitarian Law in Geneva, Switzerland. He is an Advo-

cate of the High Courts of Kenya and Tanganyika and a Certified Mediator. He is a Fellow of the Institute of Certified Public Secretaries of Kenya FCPS (K), a Fellow of the Kenya Institute of Management (FKIM) and Honorary Fellow of the African Academy of Sciences (FAAS). He is the Chairman of Farafina Investment Group in Monrovia, Liberia and Economic Strategic Growth and Development Initiative for Africa, based in Nigeria.

He is the immediate former Director and Chief Executive Officer of the Kenya School of Law, a former Secretary of the Constitution of Kenya Review Commission and a former Director of the defunct Kenya Anti-Corruption Commission (KACC). He is the Founding Trustee of the African Institute for Leaders and Leadership (AILL) and founding Chairman of the Association of the Citizens Against Corruption (A-CAC). He was the Founding Dean, Kabarak University School of Law, a former lecturer at the University of Nairobi (UON), the United States International University (USIU Africa) and Widener University USA (Nairobi Summer School).

He is a renowned legal practitioner. He has written several books including: Criminal Procedure in Kenya, An outline of Judicial Review in Kenya, Kenya's long search for a Constitution: The Postponed Promise and Judicial Review and Administrative Law. He has published numerous articles in refereed journals and several book chapters. He has also edited several Books including Devolution in Kenya (with Prof. Mbondenyi and Dr. Kabau), The Constitution of Kenya (Contemporary Readings) (with Prof. M.K. Mbondenyi and S.O. Odero). He has co-authored 'The Constitution of Kenya 2010 An introductory commentary' with Dr. Luis Franceschi. He has also co-authored several books on Ethics.

His non-legal books include: Swearing by Kenya, A

Call for Political Hygiene in Kenya, The Searching Soul, Sanitizing Kenyan Politics, Mhh Africa! (Kiswahili), Ang'o Marach (Dholuo) and Watim Ang'o (Dholuo). He has also co-authored thirteen (13) other Books on Integrity as School Series. He has recently ventured into fiction with his book 'STOLEN MOMENTS' and translated the Kiswahili play Kigogo into English as The Leader.

In 2004, he received commendation from the Kenya Scouts Association for service to the society. In 2011, Bishop Okullu of College of Theology of Great Lakes University of Kisumu awarded him the order of St. Pauls the Apostle for restoration of Good governance and right values in society. In 2012 the East African Association of Anti Corruption Authorities recognized him for valuable and exemplary contribution in the fight against corruption. Page 1 of 2 He has been named and recognized by the International Commission of Jurists (Kenya Section) and the Law Society of Kenya for his exemplary contribution to the legal profession. He was recognized by the Kenya-USA Association for the Martin Luther King Jnr., Leadership Award in 1996

and was the recipient of the 2008 Martin Luther King Africa Salute to Greatness Award by the Martin Luther King Jr. Africa Foundation. He has also been included in the Marquis Who's Who in the World and is the Distinguished Mwalimu Julius Nyerere Lecturer at the University of Dar es Salaam for 2014.

He was the 11th Kwame Nkrumah Lecturer at the University of Cape Coast in Ghana in 2016. On 27th of May, 2017, he was invested Chief Tamba Taylor of Liberia for his Pan-Africanist activities. He was the 5th Abram Tiro Onkgopotse Lecturer at the University of Limpopo in South Africa for the year 2017. He was the 5th Apollo Milton Obote Lecturer for the year 2017. He was the Nelson Mandela Centenary Memorial Lecturer at Walter Sisulu University in South Africa in 2018. He was the 2nd Ray Phiri Memorial Lecturer at the University of Mpumalanga in 2019. He was the inaugural of Samora Machel Memorial Lecturer in Maputo, Mozambique in 2021. He was the 10th Saraki Memorial Lecturer in Abuja, Nigeria, 2022. He was the 9th Sir Ahmadu Bello Memorial Lecturer in Lafia Nasarawa State, Nigeria, 2023. He was the 10th Prof J. Atta Mills Lecturer at Kwame Nkrumah University of Science & Technology in Kumasi, Ghana, 2023.

He was awarded a Lifetime Achievement for Patriotism and Advocacy by the African Forum – 2017. He was recognized by New African Magazine as one of the 100 most influential Africans in 2017. In January 2018, he received the following awards and recognition; (i) (ii) (iii) African Luminary Award by African Cultural Association in the United States of America. Freedom of the City of Lowell in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in the United States of America for his role in the fight against corruption and bad governance in Africa. Recognition by the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in the United States of America for exemplary work in the fight against corruption and bad governance in Africa. He currently practices Law with Lumumba and Lumumba Advocates and coordinates activities under the aegis of the PLO Lumumba Foundation.

CPA Prof. Elizabeth Kalunda is a seasoned professional in Accounting and Finance, both in practice and academia. She is currently an Associate Professor and previously served as the Acting Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Finance and Operations, at the United States International University Africa (USIU-A).

She has a profound interest and dedication to research, and she boasts an impressive portfolio of publications in esteemed journals. Her scholarly pursuits currently revolve around pressing issues such as Pandemics and higher education, youth employability, forensic accounting, and climate change.

As a seasoned professional, she has served at the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya (ICPAK), Dedan Kimathi University of Technology, the Government Training Institute, and the Teachers Service Commission. Her journey on the Institute Council has been marked by active engagement in diverse committees, where she has played a pivotal role. Her accomplishments include convening the Devolution Work Stream Sub-committee and the Research and Development Committee and serving as a dedicated member of committees such as Special Events, Ad hoc Human Resources, and Public Policy and Governance. Her steadfast commitment to the Research and Development Committee culminated in the successful launch of the Institute's inaugural Research Conference in 2020, which has since become an annual event.

Beyond her academic and professional endeavours, CPA Prof. Kalunda serves on several boards of directors, including Kasneb and Lofty Corban Investments Limited. She was recently appointed as a non-executive director at the Bank of India.

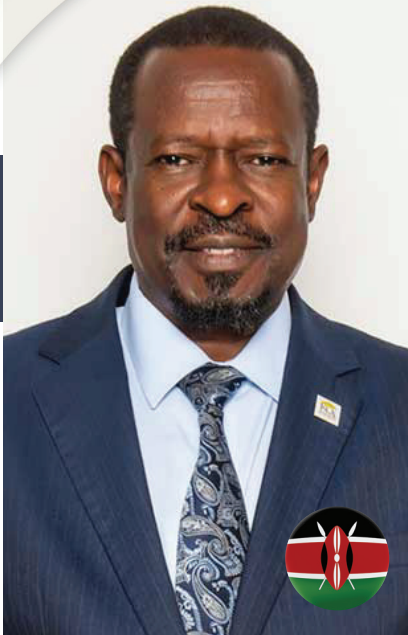

He is an active member of ISACA and a thought leader in cybersecurity risk management and digital resilience.

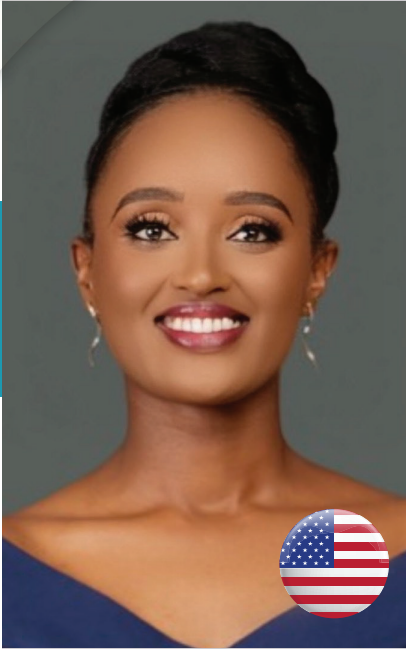
